

Parking


Parking is available behind the museum

The lobby is also a safe quiet space during your visit. Here you can find communication cards and sensory items. Just in case you need a break.




If you would like to carry something to keep your hands busy, that is ok. We have some to borrow at the greeters desk.

Please approach me with care, check in before you start talking to me.







Please do not engage with me right now.

down stairs for the restrooms








FIRST FLOOR EXHIBITION
